Where to grow your Money Tree

The Money Tree also called Jade Plant is a perfect plant for a hot window sill. The aspect can be south or west facing. This succulent loves the hot, dry and bright locations that kill most other plants.

You can grow your money tree outside for the summer in a sunny spot. The plant has to be over-wintered inside though because it won't survive temperatures below 10° C/50° F.

Watering And Feeding Your Money Tree

- ✓ **The sure killer for a money tree is over-watering!!!**
- ✓ Before watering feel the soil with your fingers. If it feels moist don't water!
- ✓ Never leave water in the saucer for a long period. What is not soaked up in 10 minutes has to be discarded.
- ✓ Frequency of watering depends a bit on the temperature, size of the plant and pot, etc. Once a week or every 10 days during the summer might be enough, less during the winter.
- ✓ Dropping leaves and shrivelled up foliage might be a sign of over-watering **not** under-watering!
- ✓ Feed your money tree once a month with a general house plant fertilizer for the growing season. No need to feed during the winter months.

Repot your Money Tree if necessary every two years. Use a free draining compost mix like cactus soil or mix a bit of sand through regular potting soil.

Follow these tips and you will enjoy your money tree for many, many years!
